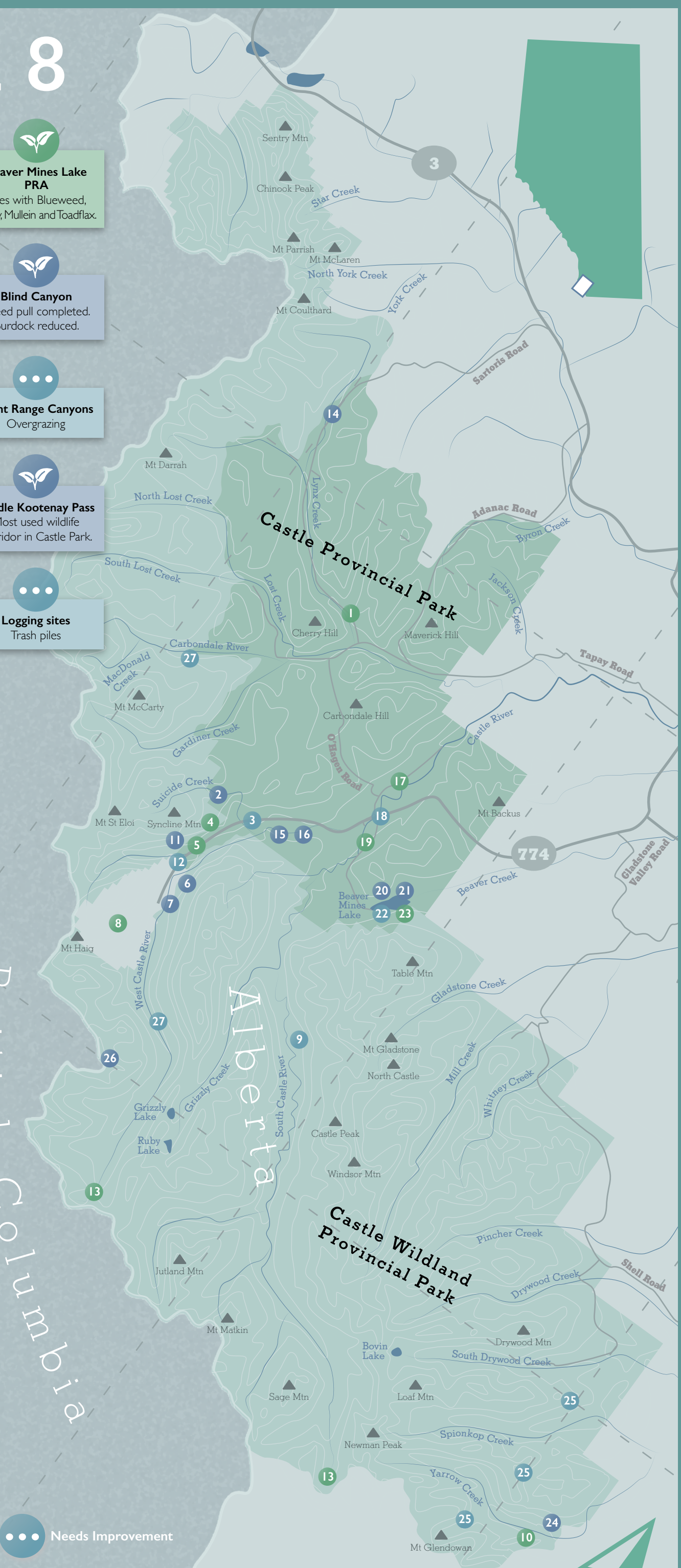


State of the Castle 2018

- 1 **Lynx Creek Road**
Sites with Henbane.
- 2 **Syncline Brook**
A new parking lot built to accommodate hikers.
- 3 **West Castle Road**
With new paving, increased traffic speeds may increase the likelihood of accidents involving cattle.
- 4 **University of Lethbridge Research Station**
Weedy area.
- 5 **West Castle Road**
Sites with Henbane, Blueweed and Scentless Chamomile.
- 6 **West Castle Road**
With random camping sites closed, damaged areas are reclaiming themselves.
- 7 **West Castle Wetland Ecological Reserve**
Weed pull completed.
- 8 **Castle Mountain Resort**
Invasive plants need controlling.

Sites with Hawkweed.
- 14 **Sartoris Road**
Weed pull completed.
- 15 **Syncline Trails**
Mullein has been greatly reduced.
- 16 **Syncline Trails**
New benches have been added on the cross-country ski trails. Fat bikes are becoming popular in the winter.
- 17 **Castle Falls Road**
Sites with Lamb's Ear.
- 18 **Castle River Bridge PRA**
Cattle found.
- 19 **Beaver Mines Lake Road**
Sites with Hawkweed.
- 20 **Beaver Mines Lake**
Shoreline clean-up completed.
- 21 **Beaver Mines Lake**
The staging area for the Table Mountain trail has been improved with tables and landscaping. A trail to the outhouse at the boat launch has been developed.
- 22 **Beaver Mines Lake PRA**
Cattle found.
- 23 **Beaver Mines Lake PRA**
Sites with Blueweed, Daisy, Mullein and Toadflax.
- 24 **Blind Canyon**
Weed pull completed. Burdock reduced.
